A) IMPORTANT NOTES:-

- I. The online updated Price BOQ is in INR format. If bidder want to quote other than INR please specify the quoted currency in the Technical Bid/Part and fill the amount in same updated BOQ.
- II. Please bifurcate the price on shipping terms i.e. Ex-works -> FCA/FOB -> CIP/CIF in price BOQ and specify the same in technical bid without mentioning the price.
- III. <u>If quoted in foreign currency, kindly clearly specify the terms of delivery/country of origin/bank details with swift code/weight/size/dimension of shipment.</u>
- IV. Restriction under Rule 144 (xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs). 2017 under sub clause 3, in terms of DOE, MoF No. F.18/37/2020-PPD dated: 8th February, 2021:

III. C) <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u>

- 1. The Online bids should be submitted directly by the original manufacturer/supplier, If quotation is submitted/filled by any representative/agent/dealer then they must upload a authority certificate from the principal company for quoting the price otherwise such quotation will be rejected.
- 2. The quantity mentioned in this inquiry is and shall be deemed to be only approximate and will not in any manner be binding on the Institute. Before the deadline for submission of the online bid, IISER Mohali reserves the right to modify the tender document terms and conditions. Such amendment/modification will be notified on website against said tender ID.

- 3. The rates offered should be FOR Chandigarh/Mohali in case of firms situated outside Chandigarh/Mohali, and free delivery at the Institute premises in case of local firms. Conditional tenders will be summarily rejected.
- 4. In case of Ex-godown terms the amount of packaging forwarding freight etc. should clearly be indicated by percentage or lump sum amount in the BOQ. Institute has policy not to make any advance payments towards any purchase. However, Letter of credit (FLC) can be opened upto maximum of 90% for the shipment value, in case of Global Tender Enquiry and balance 10% through wire transfer subject to fulfilling the conditions of purchase order (on INCO-TERMS CIP/CIF etc.).

Technical Specifications of Benchtop EPR spectrometer with accessories:

External PC controlled Benchtop EPR Spectrometer with essential software should be able to study the free radicals, transition metal complexes etc. in liquid as well as solid samples at room and liquid nitrogen temperatures.

Requirements

- 1. Should be able to study the free radicals, transition metal complexes Cu(II), Mn(II), Fe(III) complexes etc. in liquid as well as solid samples at room and liquid nitrogen temperatures (77K) and all accessories needed for it like
 - i) Glassware starter kit consisting of holders, quartz sample tubes etc.
 - ii) EPR tubes, Capillary measurement Kit consisting of capillary tubes, capillary guidance tube, holder, sealing kit.
- 2. Minimum concentration required for solution measurement of organic free radicals and transition metal complexes (Cu(II), Mn(II), Fe(III) complexes etc.) should be specified for both room temperature and 77K measurement.
- 3. Operating frequency: X-band with range: 9.2 to 9.6 GHz
- 4. Microwave power: $1\mu W 100 \text{ mW}$ or more
- 5. Sensitivity: 5 x 10¹³ spins/T or better
- 6. S/N ratio: 600:1 or better
- 7. Field Modulation:1 uT 1 mT
- 8. Field sweep range: 0 to 625mT or more
- 9. Field homogeneity: +/- 5uT within sample region
- 10. Field stability:1.0 uT/h or better
- 11. Modulation frequency: 10 kHz and 100 kHz
- 12. Magnetic field range: 0 to 650 mT or higher
- 13. Sweep resolution (field & time): >125,000 points
- 14. Resonator: Rectangular TE 102
- 15. Electro magnet: Air cooled with magnetic field control.
- 16. Cold Finger Dewar with holder for measurement at liquid nitrogen temperature.
 Two quantity should be quoted for cold finger dewar.

- 17. Software for data processing/evaluation, Computer controlled operation of spectrometer, automatic tuning, integration & differentiation of spectra, data management/report generation, print-out etc.
- 18. EPR Simulation software should also be provided.
- 19. Standard reference samples weak & strong pitch, DPPH or any other free radicals and metal salt.
- 20. Suitable i5 or i7 PC and laserjet printer
- 21. Suitable UPS with 30 min or more backup to the instrument as well as PC
- 22. **Training:** Installation, Familiarization & Training should be given at our lab with no additional charge.
- 23. **Warranty:** One year warranty on complete system including Benchtop EPR, Computer, Printer, & UPS.

The above Benchtop EPR should be compatible to following optional accessories which should be quoted separately with complete technical details

- i. Temperature Controller (complete package with all accessories), compatible to above benchtop EPR for variable temperature measurement (77K to 350K)
- ii. Spectro-electrochemical cell set up, compatible to above benchtop EPR: Measurement of EPR during bulk electrolysis in solution state at room temperature as well as 77K
- iii. Flat Cell Cuvette with holder for aqueous sample
- iv. Temperature controller for biological samples
- v. Optical Stimulation unit: Integrated light source and external Irradiation unit
