- Q1. What is the purpose of library classification system, and how does it contribute to the effective organization of library collections?
- Q2. What are the emerging trends in library technology, and how are they shaping the future of libraries?
- Q3. How to create a multilingual record for regional language books in KOHA, explain the use of MARC tags. Also explain, how to ensure these multilingual records are properly indexed and retrieved when the user searches for any of it.
- Q4. What are the ethical and legal considerations related to digital libraries, including issues of copyright, intellectual property, and data privacy; and how can libraries navigate these challenges while providing open access to information?
- Q5. What are some of the challenges and security considerations associated with computer networks in libraries, and what measures can be taken to ensure the protection of sensitive user data?
- Q6. How do libraries address the challenge of balancing access to information with concerns of misinformation, fake news, and biased content in their collections and services?
- Q7. What are the key components of information literacy, and how can libraries impart the information literacy skills to the users?
- Q8. Assertion: Advancements in the field of Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence (AI) will result in the reduction of manpower requirements for running the libraries.
